

DCC In-Studio Guidelines and Consent

- Any student with signs of sickness, or family members with signs of sickness, must remain home; students showing signs of communicable sickness will be excluded from entry or asked to be picked up immediately. Symptoms include base temperature of over 100° F, coughing, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain not related to injury, sore throat, excessive sneezing or runny nose, new loss of taste or smell, complaints of upset stomach or nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.

Student & Parent Protocol for In-Studio Attendance

- Students must come dressed and ready for class; dance bags will be kept at their designated spots.
 - As of the start of the 2021 Fall Semester, masks will be **mandatory for all students and visitors ages 3 and up, and faculty**. Dancers are permitted to stop and rest or step outside to remove their mask if they need to. Teachers will follow the same recommendations.
 - Students must bring their own labeled water bottle. They can refill their bottle if necessary but will not be permitted to drink from the water fountain or share water with other students.
 - Restrooms may be used during class, and please have students use the restroom before attending class. Each studio will have it's own designated bathroom to be used by only those in that particular studio.
 - Students are asked to wait in their cars until their scheduled class. When the teacher opens the studio door, please maintain a minimum 6ft. of social distancing as you wait to enter. Students in the advanced/prepro division may enter the studio when they arrive.
 - Students will use the exterior hand washing station.
 - Students in the Childrens, Primary, and Intermediate Division will enter directly into their studios when possible. Students taking class in studio 1, 3, or 4 will enter directly from outside into those studios using the exterior doors; only students taking class in studio 2 will be permitted to walk through the lobby.

- Students will hand sanitize upon exiting the building.
 - Students must be picked up immediately following class. Prepro dancers may wait in the building if they are staying for evening classes. If your dancer is taking a bus to the studio they may enter when they arrive.

Increased Sanitation & Health Safety Practices

- All barres, surfaces and restrooms will be sanitized before and after every class. Hand sanitizer will be available to every student upon entering and exiting the building.

- We have installed hand sanitizer and soap dispensers throughout the studio. If you need to use the restroom, please use a clean paper towel to open/close the door and turn the sink on/off.
- Students and instructors are required to hand sanitize before exiting and upon re-entering their studio.
- Students are not permitted to drink from the water fountains. They are permitted to fill water bottles only.
- Students exhibiting any signs of sickness during class will be removed from the classroom and parents will be contacted to pick them up immediately.
- As of the start of the 2021 Fall Semester, masks will be **mandatory for all students over the age of 3, visitors, and faculty**. Dancers are permitted to stop and rest or step outside to remove their mask if they need to. Teachers will follow the same recommendations.
- We encourage parents who choose to stay during class to remain in their cars, and students must be picked up immediately following class.
- All disinfecting products are commercial grade from Cleaning, Solutions & Supplies, LLC. - We have installed premium HVAC filters that captures viruses, bacteria, and allergens.
- i-Wave HVAC air purification systems have been professionally installed in all 4 HVACs that were tested and proven to reduce and inactivate 99.4% of airborne and surface Covid-19.
