Registration and Payment Policies

- All classes must register by semester with exception of the Pre-Pro Program which requires registration for the full school year.
- Our yearly registration fee of \$40/Family is due at the time of registration and $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right)$ is non-refundable.
- Semester Tuition is due in full at time of registration and is nonrefundable. If registering for 2+ classes/week an installment payment option is available
- If enrolling in 1 class and special payment arrangements are required, please $\,$ contact us at register@danceconservatorychs.com.
- We offer a 5% discount for full payment for the year (Fall and Spring Semesters together) and a 10% sibling discount.
- DCC requires a payment method on file at the time of registration. This payment method will be used for processing tuition payments and tuition nstallment payments when applicable.
- All payments will be charged a payment surcharge of 3.5% for credit card payments or a 1% surcharge for ACH payments.
- Students enrolled in the fall semester, will automatically be enrolled in the Spring semester unless they submit the Spring Semester Enrollment Change Request Form (found on the parent portal) prior to December 15. Please note: Enrollment changes by email, phone, or text will not be accepted.
- Full tuition is due regardless of the number of classes attended.
- Make up classes may be made during the semester at the same or lower level than the student is currently enrolled in.

BALLET DRESS CODE

Girls: Color appropriate leotard for their class level with pink-footed tights, pink leather ballet slippers and/or pointe shoes OR with flesh toned tights, slippers and/or pointe shoes to match as close to the student's natural skin tone as possible.

All hair must be pulled back into a neat bun, and short hair must be secured away from the face. No leotards with attached tutus or skirts, and underwear is not to be worn under the leotard. Please have new pointe shoes inspected by a teacher before sewing.

Boys: white t-shirt, black tights or athletic shorts, white socks and white or black leather ballet shoes. This applies to all class levels.

JAZZ, TAP, HIP HOP, CONTEMPORARY DRESS CODE

 $\textbf{NO CROP TOPS FOR ALL CLASSES! NO JEWELRY} \ \text{except for small earrings}.$

Hair pulled back and out of face for all classes.

Warm-ups must be taken off after first 10-15 minutes of class.
