#### **Registration and Payment Policies**

- All class registrations are for the 2023/2024 school year, August-May, with the option to withdraw from the Spring semester prior to December 15.
- Registration in the Pre-Professional Program requires a full year commitment, both fall and spring semesters, and is not eligible for withdrawal between semesters.
- Our yearly registration fee of \$50/Family is due at the time of registration and is non-refundable.
- Semester tuition is due in full at the time of registration and is
- non-refundable. Spring semester tuition will be processed on January 1.For students registered in the Intermediate and Advanced Divisions for 2+
- classes/week per student, an installment payment option is available.

- We offer a 5% discount at the time of registration for full payment for the year (Fall and Spring Semesters together) and a 10% sibling discount.
- DCC requires a credit card on file at the time of registration. Credit cards are the ONLY payment method accepted. The credit card on file will be used for processing registration, tuition, and performance fees. No additional credit card fees applied.
- Upon registration, students are enrolled for the school year, both fall and spring semesters. A student may withdraw from the Spring semester by submitting the Spring Semester Enrollment Change Request form, found on the parent portal, prior to December 15. Please note: Enrollment changes by email, phone, or text will not be accepted. Additionally, mid-semester withdrawals are not accepted.
- Make up classes may be made during the current semester at the same or lower level than the student's current enrollment.
